## AT Team England Fly Fishing (AT TEFF) Loch Style National 2019 Booking Terms & Conditions

I wish to enter the 2019 Angling Trust TEFF Qualifier at this venue.

I agree to abide by the competition rules of Angling Trust Team England Fly Fishing.

I have read the AT-TEFF Competition Rules that are published on the AT-TEFF web site ([www.teff.org](http://www.teff.org)). I have also read the document which contains 'Guidance notes for loch-style qualifier entrants' and 'FAQs'. (You are strongly recommended to read these documents in their entirety as they cover the processes involved from the amended 2018 Multiple Entry System.)

I have also read the risk assessment for the fishery / fisheries I intend to fish.

I agree to pay an AT-TEFF entry fee of £30 per venue plus my fishing fees (which may include a small fee to cover local admin).

If I qualify for the final I undertake to join The Angling Trust and I understand that I will be unable to purchase a ticket for the Final until I become a fully valid member of the Angling Trust. I understand that if I am not a paid up member I will not be allowed to fish the final.

Entries open from 1<sup>st</sup> April at 8am and are now staggered depending on venue chosen. SEE OPENING AND CLOSING DATES ON TEFF WEB SITE & AT BOOKING SITE. See rules for details. No late entries will be accepted. Once a venue is fully booked you will be unable to fish at that venue and must choose another.

You may enter up to 3 qualifiers but each entry is £30 plus the fishing fees. NO REFUNDS WILL BE MADE.

Angling Trust volunteers play a vital and integral role in angling participation. Without their dedication and commitment, the vast majority of events simply could not happen. We believe volunteers' contributions should be acknowledged and appreciated by all anglers. Any Angling Trust member found to be abusing volunteers will be subject to disciplinary proceedings. Any non-member will be excluded from participating in future events and activities.

Anglers must be aware that ATTEFF does not have control over local rules imposed by a fishery. These rules may need to be made prior to the event and will be based on advice from the fishery. Examples would be out of bounds areas created by the water authority, areas that cannot be fished due to expected adverse weather conditions etc. Entrants should appreciate before they plan their practice strategy that AT-TEFF is subject to the H&S requirements imposed upon it by the fisheries. AT-TEFF does all it can to ensure a heat creates a level playing field for all. For example AT-TEFF has no control over when and how many fish are stocked in to a venue, whether a specific area will be out of bounds due to construction work or pumping of water / air.
